

AREA PARKS...

MEADOWLARK PRAIRIES OUTDOOR LAB

Meadowlark Prairies Outdoor Lab is an 18 acre area of land with prairie, ponds, and woods ecosystems within its boundaries. It is located on the northeast side of St. James. Visitors that come for their physical health will find marked trails that are groomed, level and 80 inches wide. Visitors interested in enhancing their mental health will find comfortable benches that overlook three beautiful ponds at which they can view, observe and relax in a natural setting. Visitors that come with education in mind will find that the trails, ponds, wooded areas and prairies will offer many opportunities to explore, discover, learn and understand nature at its best.



There is no entrance fee, and all are welcome! Pets must be leashed for the protection of upland game birds and native songbirds that are ground nesters. There are no drinking fountains or bathroom facilities at Meadowlark so visitors should plan their visits accordingly.

UNLEASHED DOG PARK

Bring your dog and make a day of it at the Unleashed Dog Park. This park is located on the northeast edge of town and is not your average dog park.

This spacious park has over two acres of wooded and grassy play area, perfect for enjoying a game of fetch or use the dog agility equipment.

EAGLE'S NEST PARK

Eagle's Nest Park lies along the south fork of the Watonwan River, in one of the most wooded and scenic areas within Watonwan County. This 80-acre park features 1.25 miles of hiking trails which double as horseback riding trails. Amenities include an open air picnic shelter, charcoal grills, picnic tables, and a comfort station with showers. Pitch a tent at one of the four electrical service camping sites and stay for the weekend.



FUN AT THE PARK

MEMORIAL PARK

If you are looking to have fun in the park, Memorial Park on St. James Lake is the place to be. There is truly something for everyone. With the scenic backdrop of St. James Lake, the park features endless recreational opportunities including multiple play areas, picnicking areas, and a paved path along the lakeshore. Bring your sports gear and play at our skateboard park, horseshoe court, disc golf course, sand volleyball court, basketball court, or gaga ball pit. You can make a day of it and rent a park shelter to host your next celebration.

SKATEBOARDING

Test your skating skills at the outdoor skate park located in

Memorial Park.

This park is equipped with ½ pipe, ¼ pipe, and a grind rail.

HORSESHOES & BEAN BAGS

Play a fun game of horseshoes or bean bags at any of the four lit horseshoe & bean bag courts. These courts are open to the public and are located in **Memorial Park** between the south shelter and the skate park.

SAND VOLLEYBALL

Bump, Set, Spike! Play some volleyball in St. James. You can play in sand volleyball courts at **Memorial Park**.

SHELTER

There are two park shelters for rent at Memorial Park and one at the Southside Park Complex. The newest shelter located near the band shelter in North Memorial

Park is a spacious 30' x 60' with capacity for 90 that includes a kitchen sink, 15 tables, eletrical outlets, serving counter, and nearby restrooms. Go to www.ci.stjames.mn.us for more information.

AREA PARKS

Playgrounds include adult and child swings, jungle gyms/climbers, merry-goround, miracle playground, sand digger, slide, and teeter-totters. St. James has several more parks to explore.

RECREATION

TIELL CAMPGROUND



Nestled between St. James Lake and the Outdoor Pool with beautiful surroundings, Tiell Campground is a camper's dream. Enjoy the lakeside view from one of the 21 RV camping sites. If you don't have a camper, no problem! There is one tent site available for your use. The campground is in walking distance to our historical Railroad themed museums and is located on the paved 4 mile St. James Area Bike Trail.

FISHING



Cast a line into St. James Lake off one of the three T-shaped fishing docks in Memorial Park. Boaters are welcome on the lake and can access the lake from the public boat landing near Tiell

Campground. Once you've caught your limit, journey over to the state-of-the-art fish cleaning station.

OUTDOOR SWIMMING



If you and your family like to swim then St. James is the place to be. The **City of St. James** Outdoor Pool is located on Tiell Drive featuring a large pool, diving boards, 150-foot water slide, and toddler splash pool.

WATERSPORTS FOR RENT



St. James Lake offers adventure with a splash! Rent single kayaks, tandem kayaks, or paddle boards and enjoy the scenery the lake has to offer. Equipment rental is available from the Outdoor Pool during business hours.

GOLFING



St. James Golf Course/Rivers Edge Grill is an 18-hole tournament golf course located just off of Highway 60, east of St. James. This beautiful, newly designed course is set amidst wooded hills and a winding creek. This course is both challenging and fun for all ages. After a round of golf, grab a drink and eat some great food in the new 7,000 square foot clubhouse.

DISC GOLF





HIT THE TRAILS

ST. JAMES AREA BIKE TRAIL & WATLINE TRAIL

St. James offers four miles of paved trail around beautiful St. James Lake. All season long take in the picturesque views of the lake, and enjoy being surrounded by nature and wildlife. You can use the trail to test your exercise endurance while enjoying the scenery, and even stop for an extra workout at an exercise station along the way. At the connection of St. James Area Bike Trail and Watline Trail, there is a gazebo that offers shade, picnic tables, benches, adult monkey bars and parallel bars. Watline Trail extends south for five miles along Highway 4, and ends at Long Lake Park. The paved trails in St. James are a great activity for all ages, with trail users enjoying the safety and location that they offer.

Expert Tip: A good starting point for your adventure is at Memorial Park where there is ample parking, picnic tables, and other outdoor activities.

THE HAMMOND HIGHWAY DESIGNATED TRAIL

For the more experienced riders you can take the 11 mile trip on the Hammond Highway from St. James to Madelia. This county highway has wide shoulders that are designated for bike riding. This route is quite flat with the exception of a hill after crossing the South Fork of the Watonwan River. These trails are a part of the Watline Trail system, which the county is hoping to expand in the future. It's great to see community members and visitors alike utilizing the trails for biking, running, walking and enjoying a fun outdoor experience.









Expert Tip

If you are lucky you can catch sight of Bald Eagles nesting throughout Watonwan County. They are easier to spot from late fall to early spring when there are no leaves on the trees

ICE RINK

Snowshoeing reveals a whole new experience in our parks and trails during the winter season. Grab your snowshoes and head to Memorial Park, Meadowlark Prairies Outdoor Lab or Eagle's Nest Park for a day of fun in the snow. Don't have snowshoes? No problem.

CROSS COUNTRY SKIING

For the cross country skiing enthusiast, there are many options. Skiers can explore scenic paths at Meadowlark Prairies Outdoor Lab, Eagle's Nest and St. James Golf Course.





AREA ICE FISHING

Ice fishing is a great way to enjoy the outdoors in the winter season, and there are plenty of options around St. James. Cut a hole and drop a line at any of the following lakes in the St. James area: St. James Lake, Long Lake, Lake Hanska, Wood Lake, or Kansas Lake.

SNOWMOBILING

If horsepower is more your style, check out the 217 miles of groomed snowmobile trails in Watonwan County maintained by the Watonwan Co. Snohawks Snowmobile Association.





A RICH HISTORY

Exploring The Heritage of St. James

HISTORICAL FIGURES OF ST. JAMES Evelyn J. Wenstrom

Evelyn J. Wenstrom (1901-2002) was born and raised in St. James. She led an adventurous life and was the first female pilot in Idaho. Amelia Earhart enlisted her assistance in organizing a woman pilot's organization in the 1930's.

Winfield Scott Hammond

Winfield Scott Hammond (1863-1915) was most notably the governor of Minnesota.

Hammond was governor while he lived in St. James in the year 1915. During his life he also served as the county attorney, school principal, and state congressman.

Moses Kimball Armstrong

Moses Kimball Armstrong (1832-1906) was instrumental in bringing the railroad to St. James, providing property for schools, establishing churches, and enlisting support for other men to invest in the community.

Alfred Robert Voss

A.R. Voss (1860-1952) was instrumental in the development of farming in Watonwan County. At one point he even convinced 150 farmers to locate to the "richly endowed" county. Over the span of his life, Voss not only contributed to farming, but donated land to communities and even started the first hospital in St. James.

1867 St. Paul & Sioux City Railroad Company named their division point St. James, three years before town existed.

1870 Railroad reached St. James. First passenger train arrived November 22 with guests dining at St. James Hotel.

1871

Two-story schoolhouse built. School bell added in 1872. **1873** Grass-hoppers arrived in July devastating crops, trees and grass. Continued into 1877.

1878 County seat moved from Madelia to St. James. 1890 Omaha Railroad erected 25 stall roundhouse.

1891 Construction began on Opera House. Current St. James newspaper, The Plaindealer, published first issue.

Getting to Know St. James





HISTORICAL MUSEUMS

Model Railroad Club & Historical Railroad Museum

Stop by to get a tour during Railroad Days or call 507-375-3241 to schedule a tour in advance! The Model Railroad Club is a train lover's dream, with model trains running through various villages and scenes. The kids will enjoy the interactive section where they get to see a village come to life at the touch of a button.

The Historical Railroad Museum contains a historical depot building, a caboose, a signal tower, and a sand tower. Even if you do not have time to schedule a tour, stop by for some great photo ops! www.roundhouseinc.org

Historical Society Museum

Step back in time at the St. James Chapter of the Watonwan County Historical Society Museum. The museum has a variety of collections and displays for your viewing pleasure. Open the 1st Sunday of each month from 1:00pm - 4:00pm, April through October.

HISTORICAL BUILDINGS DOWNTOWN Grand Opera House St. James

The Grand Opera House, also known as St. James Opera House, is a historic theatre building on Main Street. It was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2009 for its local significance in the theme of entertainment/recreation. It was nominated for being the city's principal performance venue from 1892 to 1921, bringing fine performing arts like theatre, music and comedy to a modest agricultural center, as well as hosting local events. St. James Opera House contains its auditorium on the upper floor, with retail space on the ground floor.

Watonwan County Court House

The Watonwan County Court House is the seat of government for Watonwan County, which has been in continual use since it was completed in 1896. It was listed on the National Register of Historical Places in 1987 for having State-level significance in the themes of agricultural and political/government. It was nominated for its exemplary Romanesque Revival architecture, its status as one of Minnesota's monumental Victorian

courthouses and as a local landmark, and its long-standing service as a County Seat.

Princess Theater

The Princess Theater building in St. James was built between 1913 and 1915 by Harry Nelson, to show silent movies. The theater was built as a 600 seat theater with a full balcony. In 1973 the building was purchased by the City of St. James to be used as a Community Center. The floor was made level, and the building was remodeled to include a full kitchen. bathrooms, meeting room and office space. For about 10 years the movie theater portion of the historic building was closed. In the winter of 1983 the City reopened the Princess Theater, using the restored balcony as the theater with a seating capacity of 186 people. A "Save the Princess" committee was formed in the spring of 2012, and it raised the needed funds to purchase digital equipment and surround sound to keep the theater operational. The marquee was repainted and again lit with beautiful neon lights and the lobby was recently restored. The City also built an outdoor handicap accessible ramp to the theater in the fall of 2014.

1898 Park Hotel, "the leading hotel in southern Minnesota", was built by Moses Armstrong.

Location & Population

A DIVERSE "MICRO" REGIONAL CENTER

St. James is a close-knit community located just **38 miles from Mankato on Highway 60**. We are the Watonwan County Seat, with a population of nearly 5,000 people. Our community is **culturally diverse**, with over 40% of our residents having Hispanic or Latinx ethnicity.

Living in St. James, you feel a sense of security and safety that comes from living in a small town. Our residents "watch out for each other" and we are known for our philanthropy and giving nature. Each year there are new community projects that are only made possible by fundraising efforts of community members. The community also gives an outstanding amount of money in scholarships to graduating seniors, and there are benefits, luncheons and chicken or steak fries almost every

weekend supporting various causes. We like to refer to St. James as a "micro" regional center. We are the largest community in a wide radius, offering a little bit of everything. If you make St. James your home, you can find nearly any service you need right in town, with the convenience of additional retail stores, entertainment, and outdoor recreation opportunities within 40 miles.

St. James **celebrates its cultural diversity** with a widely attended, annual
event called the Multicultural Fiesta.
Additionally, the City of St. James is
implementing inclusive housing programs
that remove barriers to success for recent
immigrants. The City's progressive work
has been **discussed on a national level**and is being looked at as a model for
other communities experiencing high
rates of immigration.

Investments in Our Community

BUILDING OUR ASSETS

St. James has seen a significant rise in large-scale investments over recent years.

INDUSTRIAL PARK – St. James has invested in land and infrastructure into the St. James Industrial Park to spur growth in industrial and commercial development. The community has seen many successes in the Industrial Park with the expansions of Great River Energy, Doda, and ICS. The St. James EDA continues to work with companies and organizations on the additional sites that are needed for future industrial and commercial expansion.

BUSINESS EXPANSIONS – The St. James business community has made major investment into the St. James area. Notable projects in recent years are Smithfield Foods, Central Farm Service (CFS), St. James Veterinary Clinic, St. James VA Clinic, and Madelia Health.


Smithfield Foods had an expansion in St. James by adding three production lines and constructing a parking lot in October 2022. Central Farm Service (CFS) has completed construction on a new 350,000-ton Feed Mill in St. James. The St. James Veterinary Clinic relocated and expanded their services to both small and large animals. In this move, they made an investment of over \$1,800,000 in renovations and equipment costs. St. James VA Clinic constructed a new facility in St. James in 2022 and opened their doors at their new location in January 2023. Madelia Health has expanded their services to the St. James community. By converting a downtown building from a bank to a clinic, Madelia Health opened a new family medicine clinic in the St. James community.

SCHOOL DISTRICT – The St. James
School District 840 passed a \$24.9
million referendum for the expansion
and remodeling of their buildings. With
this referendum the school system
was able to make renovations to their
gym facilities, media centers, security,
technology, theaters, office, and pool,
and expanded with additional classroom
space.

COMMUNITY SURVEY – The City of St. James conducted a community survey in November and December of 2022. In this survey, the majority of respondents recommended St. James as a place to live because of **SMALL TOWN CHARACTER**. The respondents also felt that **housing**, and commercial and industrial development were priorities for growth in St. James.


